



Guidelines for Visitors to Robarts Research Institute During COVID-19

To: Any visitor required for preventative/service maintenance on equipment located within Robarts Research Institute

Date: June 8, 2020 (revised July 31, 2020)

Re: COVID-19 Guidelines during Phase 1B and 2 and 3

- Visitors must enter through Robarts' main door where the security desk is located.
- Visitors will be met in the lobby by their contact person within Robarts.
- Visitors must complete the screening questions related to COVID-19. If the visitor answers "yes" to any question, they will not be allowed into the building. This document must be kept on file by the contact person at Robarts.
- Physical distancing rules will be followed. If it is not possible, masks must be worn.
- Visitors must bring their own appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE) provided by their employer (masks and gloves).
- Robarts staff will disinfect the working area will be disinfected before and after maintenance work.
- Visitors must wash hands on entrance to the lab and leaving the lab. Hand wash stations are located within the lab area. Frequent hand washing is recommended.
- Only one Robarts staff member and the visitor will be in the lab to limit the number of people in the work space.
- When work is completed, visitors must exit through Robarts' main entrance.
